

## FAMILY HISTORY TOOL FOR PEDIATRIC PRIMARY CARE PROVIDERS: Installation Fact Sheet



## Purpose of the Family Health History Tool

- Support the provider in family history risk assessment and genetic evaluation
- Identify additional evaluation, preventative services, or personalized management for children who are at increased risk for health conditions based on family health history

## Information Technology Checklist

- Installation can be customized for site(s): when, where summary prints; follow up letters
- Project staff works with site IT staff to install
- Approximate file size of the tool: 260 MB (includes SQL database, client application)
- Wireless connection to tablet, laptop, or desktop computer with 'patient clipboard' software installed
- Wireless connection to office printer for automated printing of family history report is ideal
- .NET IT environment (version can be >= 2.0)

## **FAQ**

Q Can I still install if I do not have a dedicated IT staff or have an electronic medical record (EMR) system currently?

A Yes, the system can work independently of an EMR

Q Can this integrate with my EMR?

A Yes, summary report can be scanned and imported into your EMR or delivered through Continuity of Care Document. Data is interoperable if EMR uses HL7 Pedigree model v3 data standard

Q Can I use an iPad or have my patients fill this out at home or on a mobile devices (over the web)?

A No, the pediatric questionnaire is not available for iPad or as a web survey at the moment Q What is the average amount of time to set-up and install all necessary hardware, software, and wireless networking for server, physician, and patient components (complete solution)?

A 10-40 hours depending on size of staff, patient flow, IT infrastructure or desired customizations
